## **Golf Memo #3: April 28, 2026**

**Regional Sites & Assignments:** We are going to stick with our original regional release date of **Wednesday, May 6<sup>th</sup>**. Many rescheduled meets have already taken place or will be played prior to that date so we feel we will have a good data set to make assignments. Additionally, it will still give schools time to play practice rounds at regional sites if they wish to do so. Regional assignments will be posted on the IGHSAU website on the Tournament Central page. IGHSAU will set up all meets on Bound.

**Regional "Opt-Out":** I know there are some programs who have a small number of golfers and haven't necessarily been playing them in many varsity meets...or maybe you ended up not having any golfers at all. If you know for certain that you won't be sending any athletes to a regional meet, will you please let me know by the end of the week if possible? If it's still up in the air, no need to notify me.

**Bound Entries:** Couple things to keep in mind for Bound entries

- 1) You must enter individual scores at the same time you enter team scores
- 2) Enter individual scores under the STATS tab
- 3) **Don't** enter a 0 in an individual players score box if they didn't compete that round
- 4) Enter par for the course correctly
- 5) Enter course rating correctly (use correct tees when calculating)
- 6) Select 9 or 18 holes
- 7) SAVE, SAVE, SAVE! Save Round and Save Scores after you've entered the information

***Please ensure all your scores, both team and individuals, are updated by the end of the day TODAY.***

**Postseason Manual** – Postseason manual is posted on the golf page. Please start to familiarize yourself with items in the document. One notable change made from last year: all schools may have two school-approved, certified coaches at regionals...regardless of if you have a team or individuals participating. The same will be true at state meets.

**Live-scoring:** Host sites for regional meets are permitted to have golfers live-score the event. Physical scorecards must still be used and will be the official method of keeping scores. At the state meets, we will once again have golfers live-score their rounds using the Golf Genius app.

**4A State @ Waverly:** I mentioned in the last memo that Waverly Municipal does not have a formal driving range on site. However, there will be a location near the clubhouse with 18-20 hitting bays where athletes can warmup. Additionally, Palmer's Family Fun in Waterloo will open at 6:30 am each day to accommodate any teams/golfers who wish to warm-up off site. There is an information graphic at the bottom of this memo.

**State Coed Meet** – State Coed meet is June 9. Information and online registration link for the coed meet is located on both the IGHSAU and IHSAA websites. Coed meet is capped at 68 teams per class. Deadline for registration is June 1st. Please note that there only two classifications for the coed meet (1A / 2A – based on BEDS). Your regular season classification is not necessarily your coed classification. Those details are outlined on the registration page.
